When a baby is lost, whether during pregnancy, at birth or in infancy, it is a devastating experience for the parents and the extended family. Sadly for people that lose prior to 24 weeks gestation, services to commemorate life are seldom held, while for parents who lose later in pregnancy, at birth or in early years, the parents are usually in the depths of grief when a service is held. Saying Goodbye services provide a time and place to acknowledge and remember your baby, whilst collectively 'saying goodbye'. **ATM ('hole in the wall' cash dispensers ) CASH FRAUDS.** Have you withdrawn cash from the Tesco cash machines in Heacham or Hunstanton, or McColls in Heacham within the last 10 days or so? Might be wise to check your statement to see if there are any unrecognised transactions. Several hundred local people (including me!) have already had their bank cards 'cloned' enabling thieves to make unauthorised withdrawals. If you see a debit to a name you don't recognise you should visit your bank straightaway or go to your bank's website to record the possible fraud. Your account will be then protected and refunds can then usually be made. Adrian
